When is it time for Hospice Care?

Criteria to look for when referring for Dementia

When a combination of the following characteristics are present, a patient may qualify to recieve hospice care: Functianlitiv

- Requires assistance from others to bathe and get dressed.
- Is unable to walk without assistance.
- Is incontinent of bowel and bladder.
- Is unable to communicate verbally, his or her vocabulary is limited to 6 or fewer words.
- Is unable to smile
- Is unable to keep head up independently
- Is unable to sit up without assistance

Conditions within the past 12 months

- Urinary Tract Infection.
- · Asperation Pnemonia.
- · Septicemia.
- Pressure Ulcers.
- Fever, recurrent after antibiotics.
- Inability to maintain sufficient fluid and caloric intake demonstrated by 10% weight loss <u>OR</u> serum albumin <2.5 gm/dl.
- **In the absence of one or more of these findings, rapid decline or comorbidities may also support eligibility for hospice care.
